1. Go to [www.chevroncitytosurf.com](http://www.chevroncitytosurf.com) and select the Perth location
2. Click on Register—Perth
3. Select your distance (12km Run, 4km, etc.) Mrs Armstrong has joined the 4km run in the second wave.
4. Click on **Join a Team**
5. Type in our Team: *Hillarys Primary School – The Power Pack*
6. Type in our team password *Hillarys* to join
7. Fill out the registration form.
8. We have selected "Payment by Individual" so you will need to pay for your registration and you will receive a confirmation email with your e-ticket.

Unfortunately the bibs are only available to collect from Forest Chase from Friday 25 August. Mrs Armstrong is happy to collect these and distribute at school at 12 noon on Saturday 26 August (the day before the event). If you choose this option you will save the postal fee which is an additional \$6.50 on top of the each entry.
