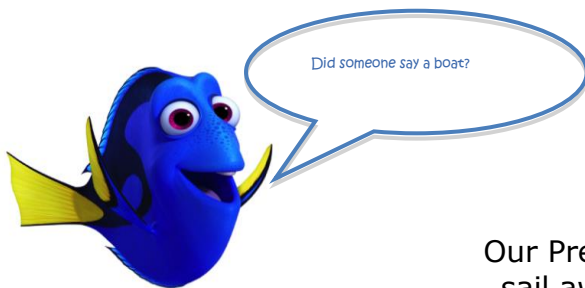
A big thank you to all the families who have been placing their vouchers in the boxes. We are well on our way to gathering enough vouchers to purchase sporting equipment from our school wish list.

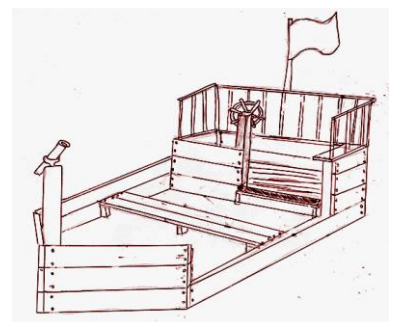
Our Pre-Primary students would love to sail away with their imaginations and they need your help!
