OPEN NIGHT

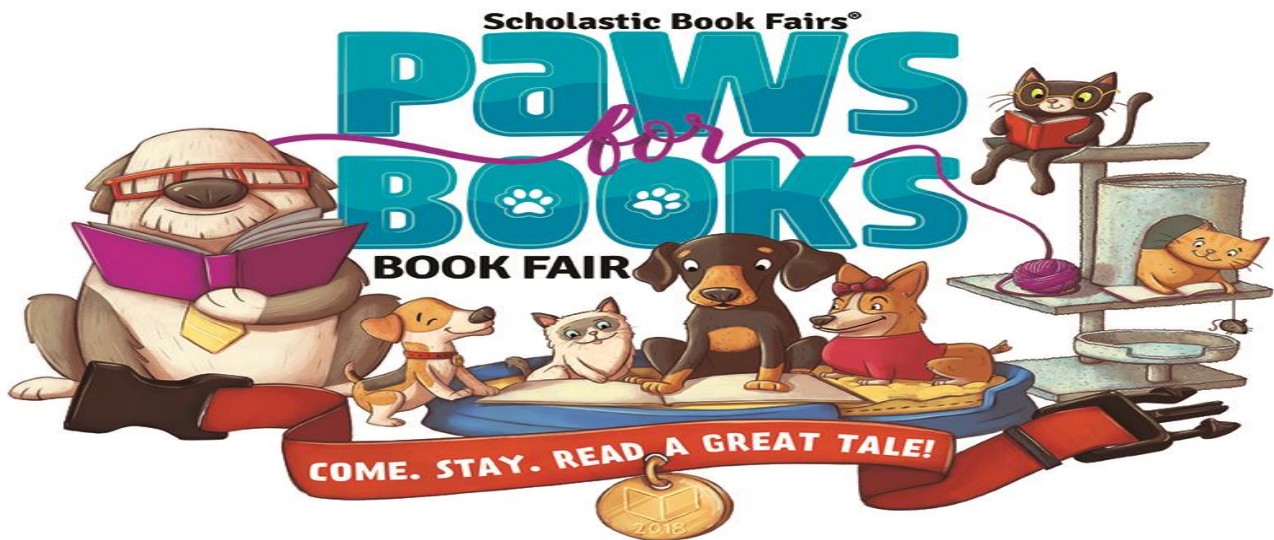
