# ENGAGED EDUCATORS



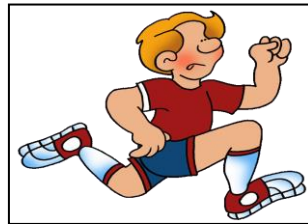
We are hosting a Scinema screening as part of the International Science Film Festival 2018.

### Host a Japanese Student in October

Thanks to the support of the families in our school community we ran a very successful cultural exchange program at Hillary's Primary last October in conjunction with Gold Intercultural Learning. As those families who hosted have already discovered, hosting an international student offers many unique opportunities, including the chance to learn about another culture and build life-long friendships.

Gunma Kokusai Academy will visit us again this year from October 14th through to October 31<sup>st</sup>. GKA is an English immersion school so students speak and understand English well. These students are in Year Six and are usually eleven years old.

All students in Year Five and Six may apply and will be matched according to gender, and where possible, by age and interests.

Our visitors will accompany host students to their regular classes and interact with them and their friends at recess and lunch.

The family's responsibilities are to involve the student into their routine, including getting them to and from school and to provide breakfast, lunch and dinner. Host families will receive a hosting payment to cover expenses.
